








#### National program for Clinical Treatment Research - KLINBEFORSK

KLINBEFORSK

• Funding for clinical multicentre studies



- Key features:
  - $\circ~$  All four health regions must be involved
  - o Bottom-up
  - Exploratory biomarkers for stratification and personalized treatments should be applied where relevant
  - o New study designs such as decentralized clinical studies are encouraged
  - o International projects are possible, but Norwegian involvement must be central at all levels
  - National infrastructure for clinical trials (NorCRIN) should be used
- Yearly deadline, medio May





### The Norwegian Cancer Society (NCS)

- Research projects
  - Free cancer research
  - $\circ~$  Thematic both Pink Ribbon and other fundraiser activities
  - Young talents



- Qualification projects
  - Funding for projects where the primary objective is to thoroughly explore and pinpoint the most promising commercial application prospects, including service innovation, in research findings
- Pioneer Projects
  - Funding for projects for early-stage exploration of novel and innovative ideas with potential for breaking new grounds in cancer research


